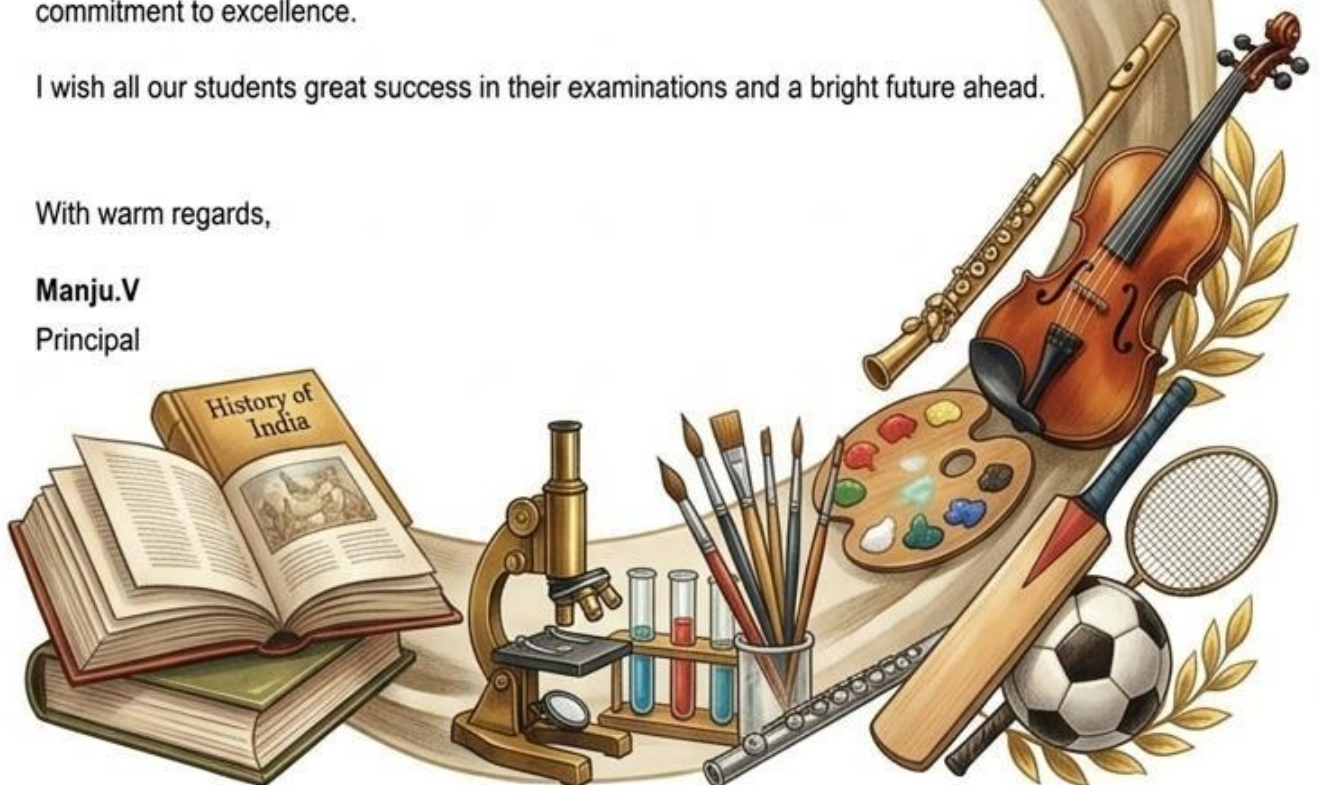

In addition, repair work was carried out on the terrace to prevent water leakage, ensuring a safer and more comfortable environment for students and staff.

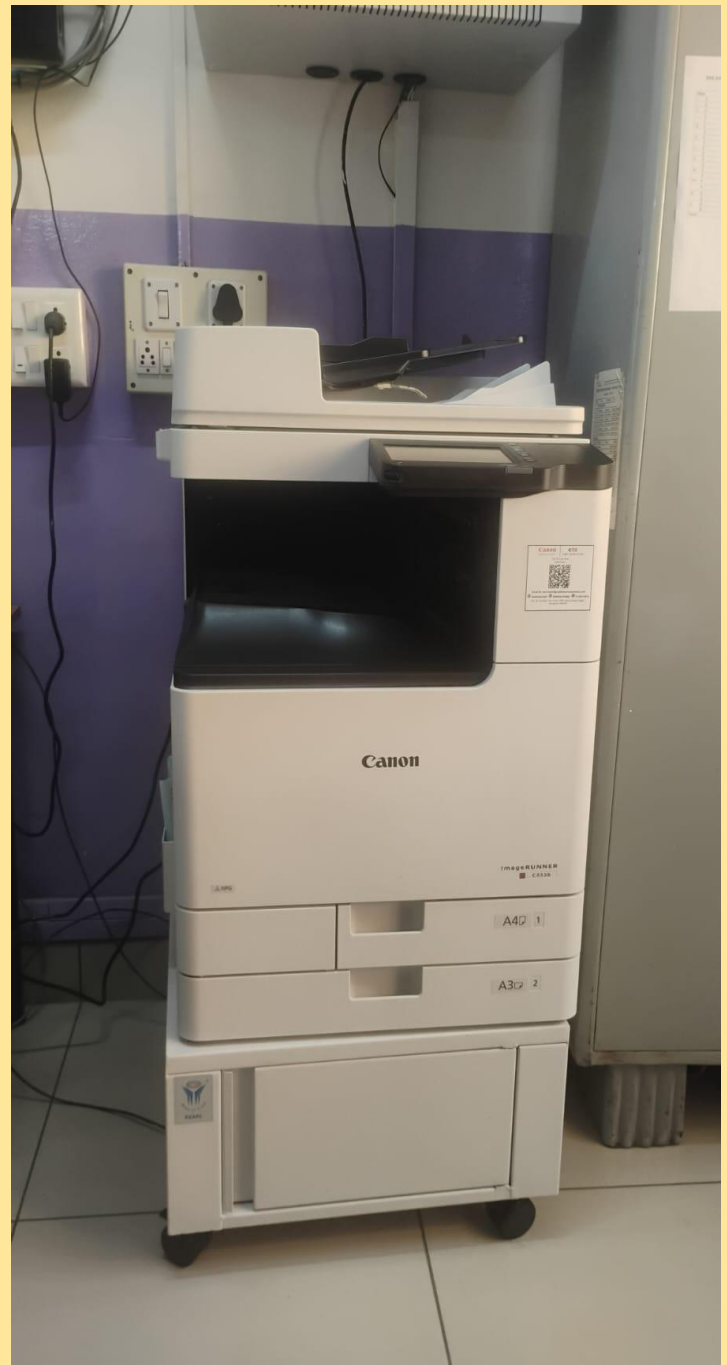

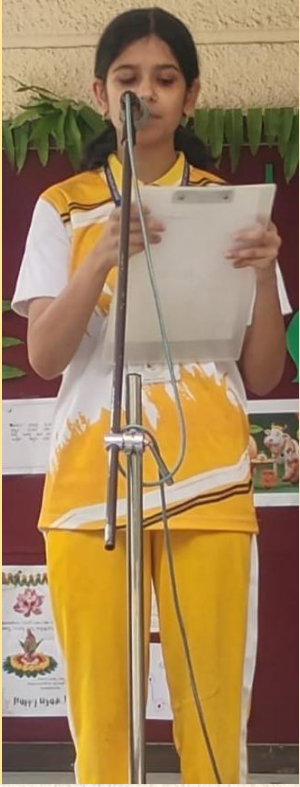
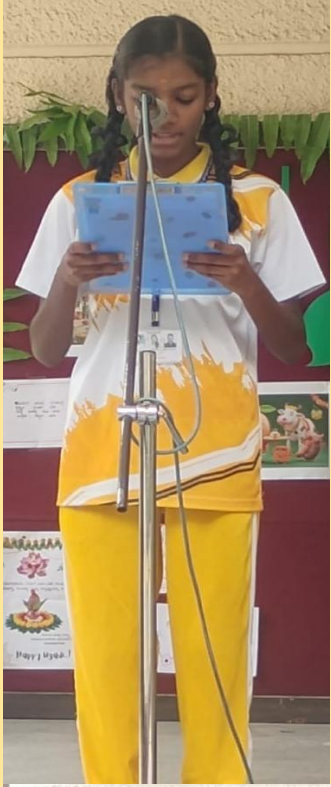

After a busy and hectic year, this outing gave everyone a chance to relax and enjoy. The staff members spent time together, played games, and enjoyed the peaceful surroundings.

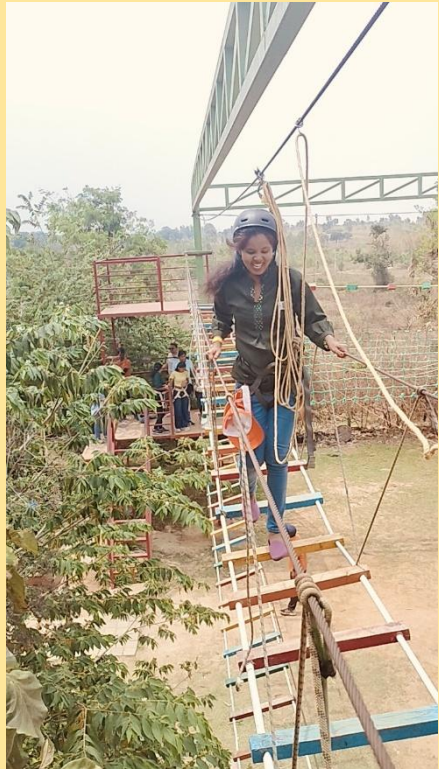
It was a joyful day filled with fun, laughter, and bonding. The outing helped everyone feel fresh and happy.

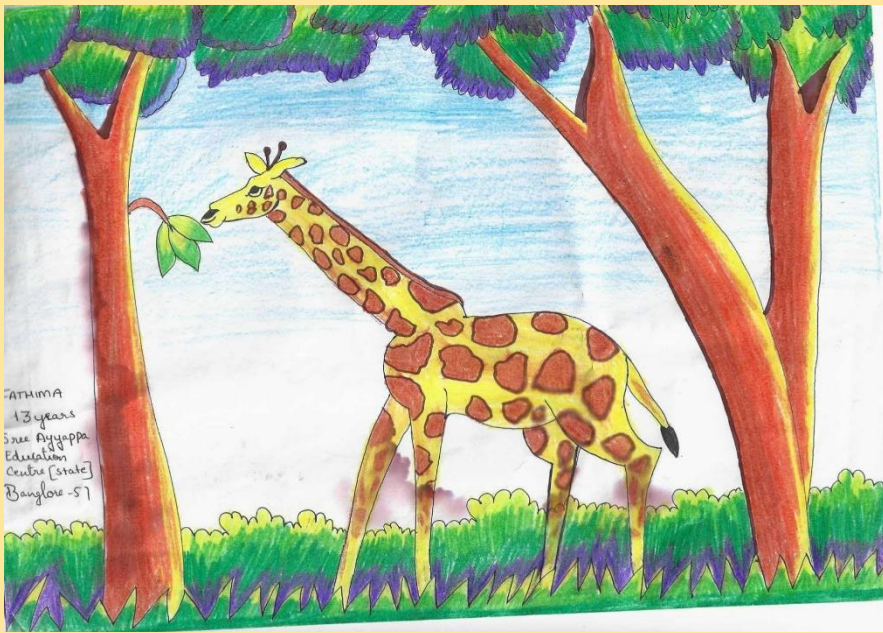

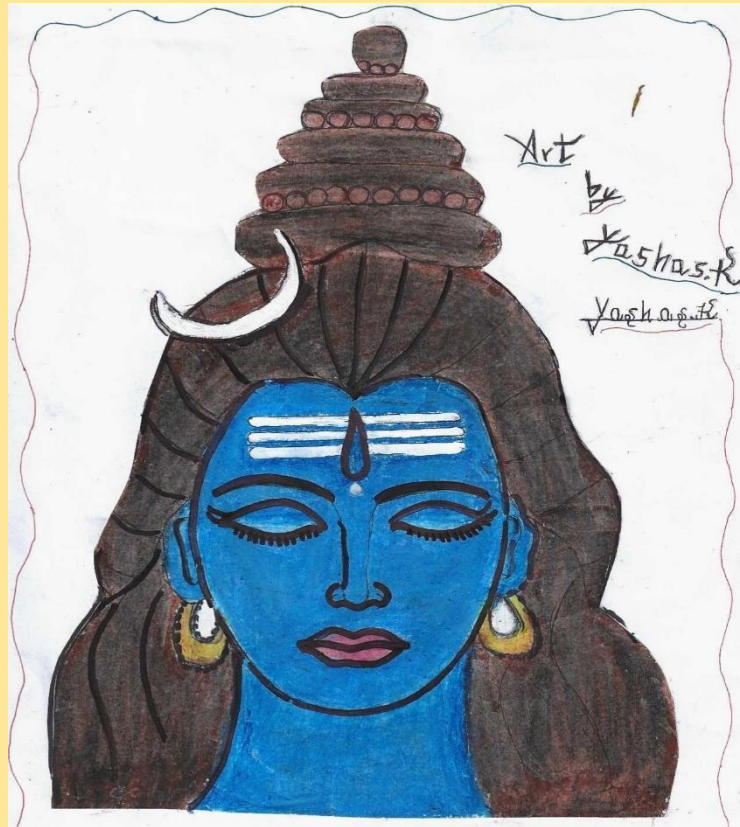
